



# Pharmacists Providing Maximum One Month Medication Supply

To ensure the continued supply, and to prevent the stockpiling of prescription medication, Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living will require that, effective immediately, Manitoba pharmacists limit the number and quantity of prescription drug dispenses as follows:

- Manitoba pharmacists may only provide a ONE MONTH supply (to a maximum of a 35-day supply) in a 28-day period for ALL DRUGS.
- This restriction applies to all prescriptions regardless of whether the patient pays or has a private or public Drug Plan.
