

Pharmacists Manitoba Membership Policy

Membership Renewal

1. Immediate Family

Immediate family members of a Pharmacists Manitoba member are entitled to access Pharmacists Manitoba Member Benefits Program. A member's immediate family is defined as follows: i) Parents; ii) Spouse; and iii) Children.

2. Refunds

Refunds will be given in the follow circumstances when requested:

- Retirement - Refunds will be given to members retiring from the profession. CPhM must verify their retirement (pro-rated).
- Maternity Leave - Refund will be given to members on maternity leave (pro-rated).
- Death – Refund will be given to spouse upon death of member (pro-rated).

Out of Province - Pharmacists moving out of province will be able to maintain their malpractice insurance through Pharmacists Manitoba until the end of the membership year, as it is valid across Canada.

Membership Dues

Early Fee: Paid before June 15th of each year

Full Fee: Paid after June 15th of each year

Pro-rated: From January 1st to June 30th memberships are pro-rated based on the Full Fee
Additional professional liability insurance is also pro-rated (June 15th to December 31st members pay full fee).
